#### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

#### FIELD TRIAL DOG CLASS FIELD TRIAL BITCH CLASS

For Afghan Hounds who are AKC registered and have not had their coats shaved and meet all AKC eligibility requirements according to the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 8 and are confirmed Field Champions or Coursers of Merit. Note: A copy of the certificate awarding the title or a copy of the ENTIRE PAGE from either the AKC Gazette or FAN magazine publishing the title will be accepted as proof. Dogs will not be entered into this class without proof of title accompanying the entry form. The winners of these classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition provided they have not been defeated in another class.

#### VETERAN DOG CLASS VETERAN BITCH CLASS

For Dogs and Bitches 7 years & under 9 years, For Dogs and Bitches 9 years & under 11 years, For Dogs and Bitches 11 years & older. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Classes. The winners of these classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition provided they have not been defeated in another class.

#### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace & Breeders classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and two to four of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed Competition or may be entered for Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Get only to be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show rules, AKC policy or the standard for the Breed.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class - Effective January 1, 2005. A Brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace unit must be so designated "Brace NO. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc. PLEASE SUBMIT BRACE ENTRIES TOGETHER.

Breeders Class – Entry Fee (see pg. 3) The Breeders Class is a multiple entry class consisting of 3-5 dogs regardless of sex. This class is open to all breeders. All dogs entered must have at least one breeder in common who must be present in the class. The individual dogs comprising the entry must be from at least two different combinations of parents but need not be owned or handled by the breeder. Entrants must be entered individually in some other conformation, performance or companion class. ONE dog must be pre-entered in the class. Other 2-3 dogs; armband numbers must be submitted to the ring steward the day of the event.

#### **EXHIBITION ONLY CLASSES**

<u>Liberty Class</u> – No Entry fee: Just bring your dog, and the music to show off your dog and spend 2 minutes alone in the ring with your dog (young or old) doing whatever you want to do. This will be held on Thursday, October 17, 2024.

Parade of Veterans – No Entry Fee: Eligibility: Open to all dogs and bitches 7 years of age or older. These entries will not be judged in conformation competition. Each dog will be presented a rosette with its name inscribed. A Bronze Medallion depicting the Club emblem suspended from a Red, White & Blue Ribbon will also be offered by the Afghan Hound Club of America, Inc. VETERANS IN THE PARADE WILL BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE IN VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES AND NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE IN ANY OTHER REGULAR OR NON-REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASS AT THIS SHOW, and may compete in Obedience, Rally, Agility, one or both Lure Trials & the Triathlon. The dog MUST BE PRESENT IN THE RING in order to receive the award. NOTE: Please send a maximum of 150 words resume of the dog to the Show Secretary, to be read over the Public Address System while the dog is in the show ring. PLEASE PRINT DOG'S NAME CLEARLY FOR RIBBON IMPRINT. See below for form.

Parade of Rescue – No Entry Fee: Open to all Afghan Hounds who have been adopted through a rescue program or shelter. We honor those of you who have taken these beautiful Afghan Hounds into your lives. The Afghan Hound Club of America will present each RESCUED AFGHAN HOUND IN THIS PARADE with a rosette inscribed with the dog's name and a 2" white Enamel Medallion with AHCA Logo suspended from a White Ribbon. The dog MUST BE PRESENT IN THE RING in order to receive the award. NOTE: Please send a maximum of 150 words resume of the your dog. Please keep your Rescue resume up beat. This is to be read over the Public Address System while your dog is in the show ring. PLEASE PRINT DOGS'S NAME CLEARLY FOR RIBBON IMPRINT. See below for form.

#### BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY

The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are:

- Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show.
- Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show.
- Individually registered with The American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show.
- Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show.
- The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog.

In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle the dog in the ring.

#### **AKC National Owner-Handled Series**

#### (Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not solely owned or exhibited by professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants\*\* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed/Variety competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner- Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of
  Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety
  will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner- Handled Best of
  Breed/Variety. If neither the Best of Breed/Variety nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of
  Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are
  both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible
  Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed/Variety including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best of Breed/Variety for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.
- · If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winners are ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring. The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed/Variety or in Best of Winners competition.
