Conditions of Entry

Hounds must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5-minute grace period. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused (with entry refunded). Spayed or neutered hounds may be entered. The current President, the Show Chairperson, Co-Show Chairperson and members of the Bench Show Committee, and members of their household, shall not exhibit, nor cause to be exhibited, dogs they own, or co-own, in competitive classes at this National Specialty Show.

You will be expected to have complete info on your dog for each entry. Incomplete entries and those submitted by <u>E-MAIL</u> WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The gate to the Park is no longer locked.
- The pasture field has no amenities or shade available. Please ensure the comfort of you and your hounds by bringing your own portable shade/shelter and water.
- Permanent Restrooms available
- All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.
- Only purebred Afghan Hounds which are registered with the AKC or have an AKC ILP number may be entered.
- Each hound requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its
 acceptance.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form.
- Hounds under disqualification from AKC Field Trials may NOT be entered in OPEN, OPEN VETERAN
 or SPECIAL stakes.
- At time of inspection, bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused and their entry fee refunded.
- Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds may not be entered.
- Spayed or neutered hounds (without breed disqualifications) may be entered.
- Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched, and entry fees will not be refunded.
- Muzzles are not required; it is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hound should be muzzled.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil
 disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public
 emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club or its
 members and representatives.
- THE AFGHAN HOUND CLUB OF AMERICA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO TAKE CORRECTIVE ACTION

- Field Committee Members and Trial Volunteers may have their hounds inspected prior to the designated inspection time by the full inspection committee.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not allowed.

AKC JC and QC TESTS

JUNIOR COURSER TEST: Open to all Afghan Hounds at least 1 year of age. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge on one date and a second certification from a different judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed at least a 600 yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

AKC TRIAL STAKES

OPEN: Open to all Afghan Hounds that have attained at least one of the following: AKC Qualified Courser Title, CKC Field Champion Title, ASFA FCh Title. Championship points may be awarded from this stake. First time open entries using ASFA or CKC Field Champion Waiver must submit a Copy of the Championship Certificate with Entry. Hounds who have earned an AKC Field Championship are not eligible to enter Open. **OPEN VETERAN:** Open to all Afghan Hounds, which are eligible to enter either Open or Special Stake, and are of Veteran age as determined by their Parent Breed Club. Championship or LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

SPECIAL: Open to all Afghan Hounds that are eligible to enter the Open stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

Hounds under disqualification from AKC Field Trials may NOT be entered in OPEN, OPEN VETERAN or SPECIAL stakes.

BEST IN EVENT (BIE) will be offered as a run-off between the AKC Best of Breed and ASFA Best of Breed winners. Judges for Best in Event will be KC Artley and Jeffrey Leonard

Field & Course Plans

- The course will be reversed for Finals.
- Run-offs and Best in Event course direction will be determined at the judge's discretion.
- Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used.
- The lure will consist of plastic strips contrasting the terrain.
- The members of the AHCA reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.
- Please do not park on the grass.
